

## **2005 Collection of 2004 Data CPM Frequently Asked Questions**

1. We are unable to open CPM VA forms by clicking on the CPM 820 or 821 buttons. We get the error message "This patient is not part of the current sample. You may not add patients to the sample." The buttons on both the search screen and the PMF screen give the same results. The only way to open them is to double click on the form itself in the Forms section of the PMF

When you click on the CPM button, the code looks for the form type that is set in the Utilities >Default Options - Network Defined tab - CPM Study Phase dropdown. If this selection is set to VA Study and you click on the CPM button your VA Study CPM form will open. This selection also affects the CPM Exception Report - it will report on whatever is saved there.

2. We chose Print All 821 Forms for Sample. All 821 Forms did print, but none had black-outs.

The black out function is based on data stored in the CPM table. Since the LDO data has not been loaded, there will not be any forms with data blacked out

3. Was it finally determined that there would not be a way to separate the batches of LDO forms from non-LDO?

The current print functionality allows the user to print all CPM forms or print the CPM form by patient. There is not a batch print function by affiliation. TD# 4750 has been added as an enhancement for a future release

This is an enhancement to improve the print capabilities for LDO and non-LDO facilities. The new print functionality works as follows:

1. Print Individual Form - No Blackout
2. Print Individual Form - Blackout
3. Print all 82x forms for study - No Blackout
4. Print all 82x LDO forms for study - Blackout (RCG, DCI, Gambro, NNA, and FMCNA)
5. Print all 82x Non-LDO form for study - No Blackout (RCG, DCI, Gambro, NNA, and FMCNA)

4. The forms are printing without the "page 5" instructions, i.e., those that refer to questions 18b3-22. As the material has changed in these questions since last year, we are hesitant to forward the forms without the instructions.

The CPM form prints with the instructions up to page 4, which includes the first page of instructions. This is how the form was designed last year. If Networks would like to print additional pages of instructions, they should be printed and merged with the form from SIMS.
